

Intra batch debate of level 4M Students (February 2018).


A debate-based knowledge sharing programme was arranged for the special degree students of the Department of Zoology to develop the soft skills.

APRIL 2018.

Zoological Students' Association (ZSA) of Department of Zoology has won the UNDP/GEF/SGP small grant fund of USD \$35000.00 on a community-based project at Kavutharimunai, Pooneryn to achieve the following goals;

- Enhancing the organic homegarden practices throughout the year as a mitigation for the prevailing drought condition at Kayutharimunai.
- Increasing the socio-economic status of the beneficiaries through the business plans with the handicraft products from Palmyra.
- Developing a business plan on the edible products from Palmyra
- Restoring at least 50-100 Acres of mangrove forest at Kavutharimunai.

The major activities will be conducting awareness programs, training workshops, site visits tourism package development and so on. Our students will be involved in the mangrove restoration.

VISIT TO NORWEGEAN RESEARCH VESSEL DR.FRIDTJOF NANSEN ON 23.06.2018


Two staff members from Department of Zoology have been selected to represent Faculty of Science, UOJ along with the members of Department of Fisheries.
