- Livelihood development
- Integration of existing organizations and institutions
- Eco tourism development which was later dropped
- Development of research and field study facilities at the University of Jaffna

Project Outcome: At-least 50 ha of coastal area in Kavutharimunai, Pooneryn environmentally restored

- Output 01: At-least one transitional mangrove nursery set up at Department of Zoology, UOJ
 - Obtaining training from a mangrove specialist on setting up the mangrove nursery
- Output 02: Establish 25-50 ha small mangrove forest in Kavutharimunai, Pooneryn
 - Conducting at-least 3 awareness programmes for the public and stakeholders on the project activities
 - Restoring 25000- 40000 mangrove plants at the selected site in Kavutharimunai






Enhance productivity and Sustainability of small holder agro ecosystem




